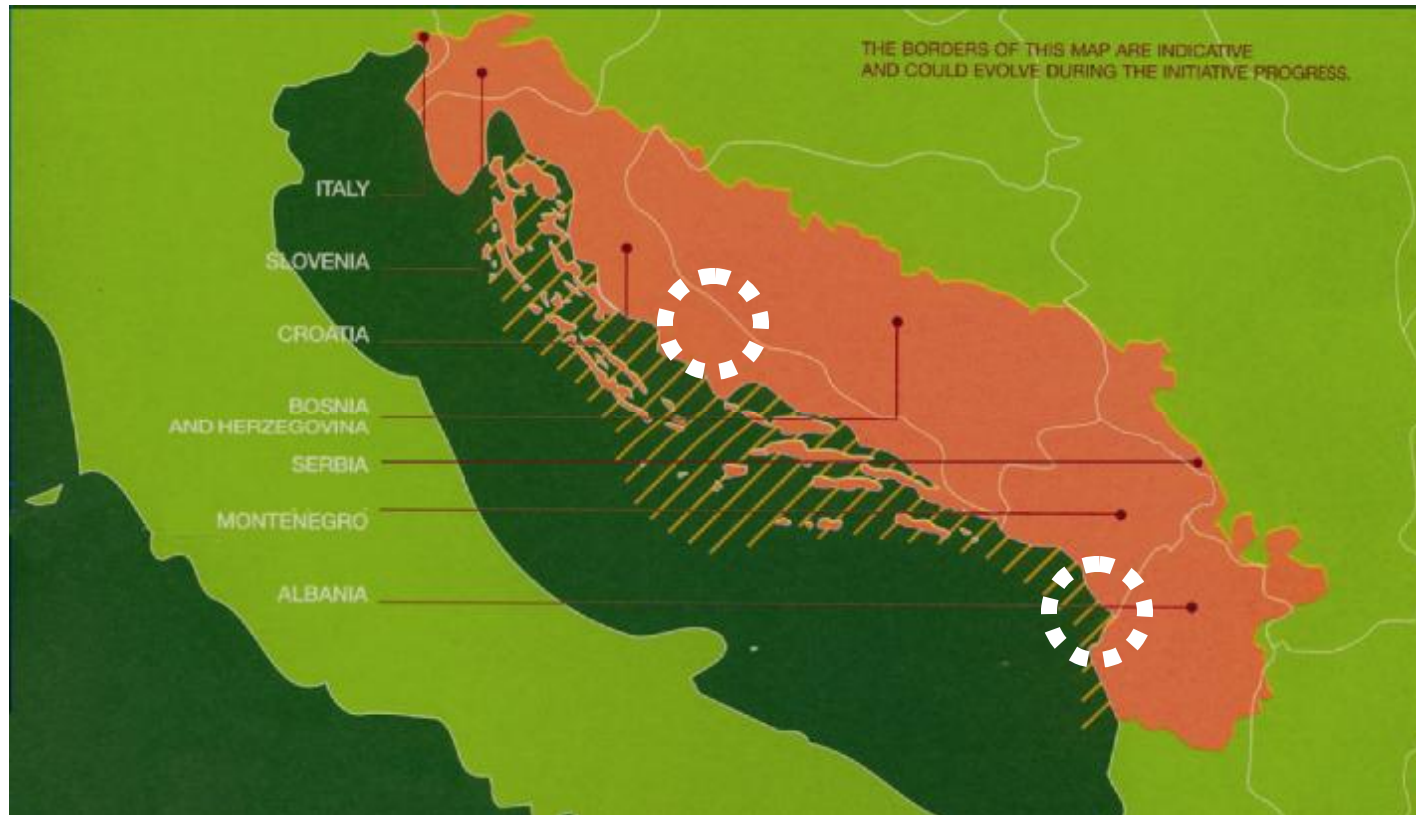

# Ohrid-Prespa Lakes: The challenge of a territorial system

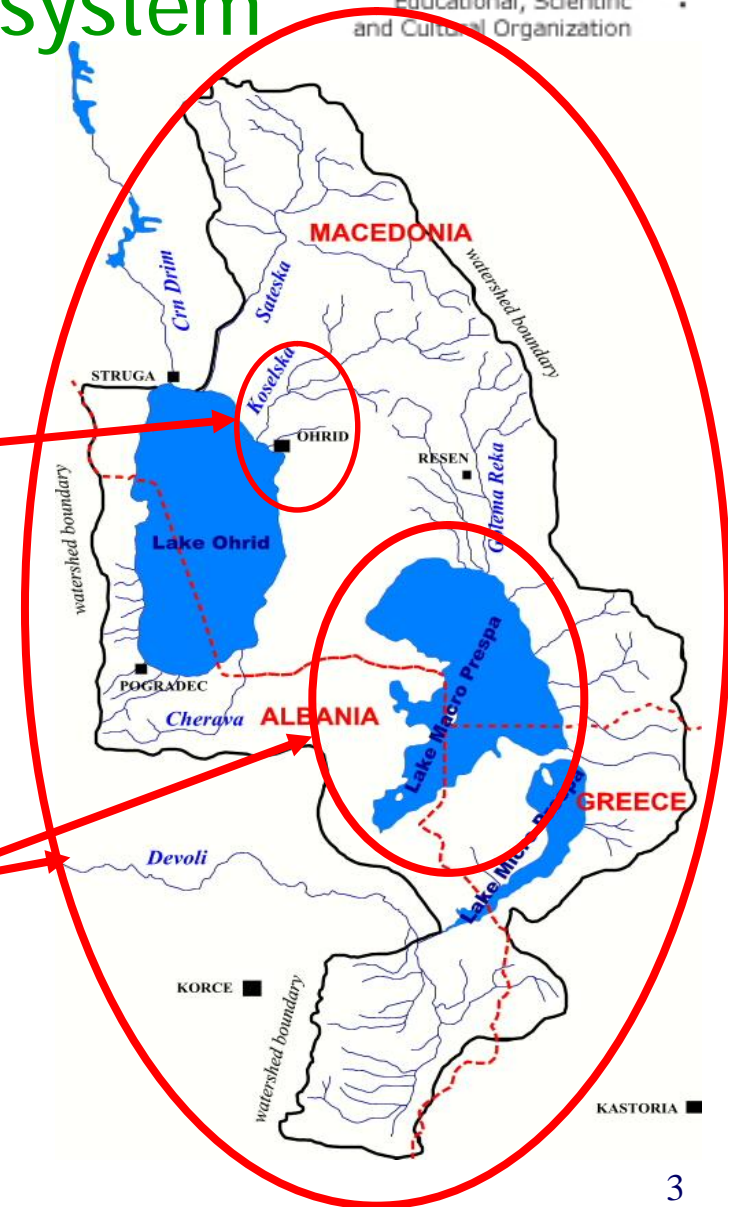

Environment (1979-80)

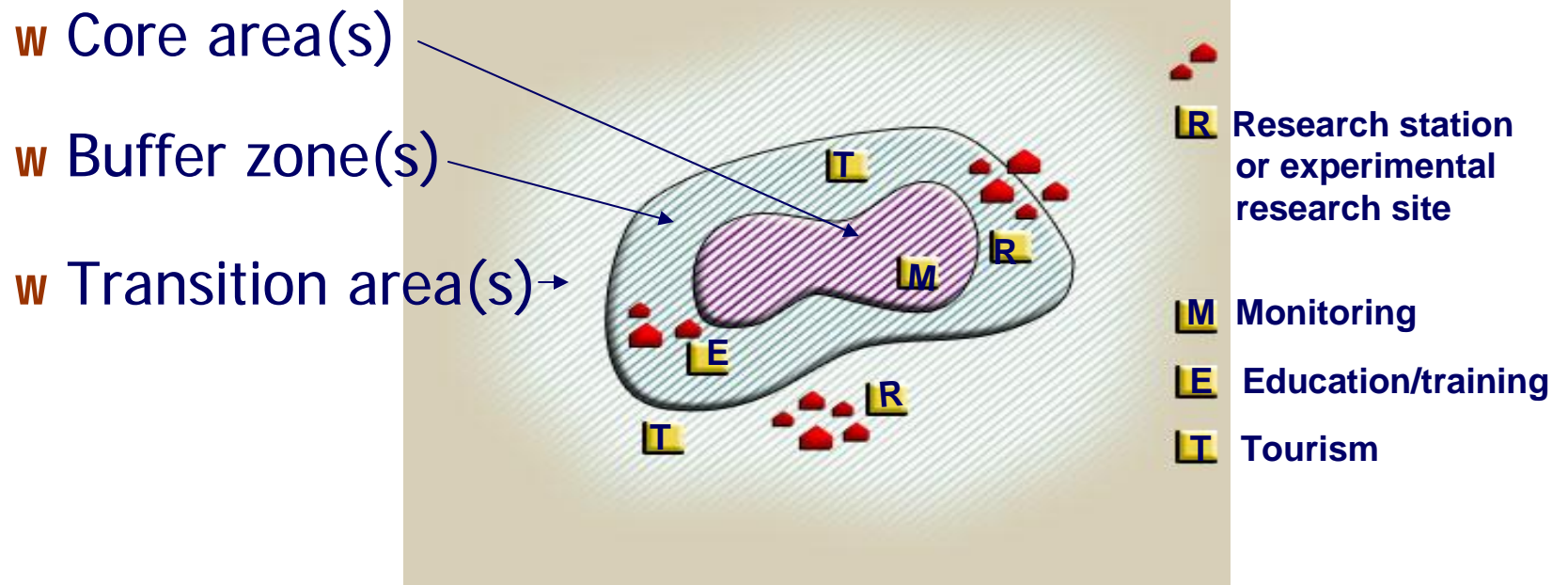

# Biosphere Reserves: Flexible Zoning

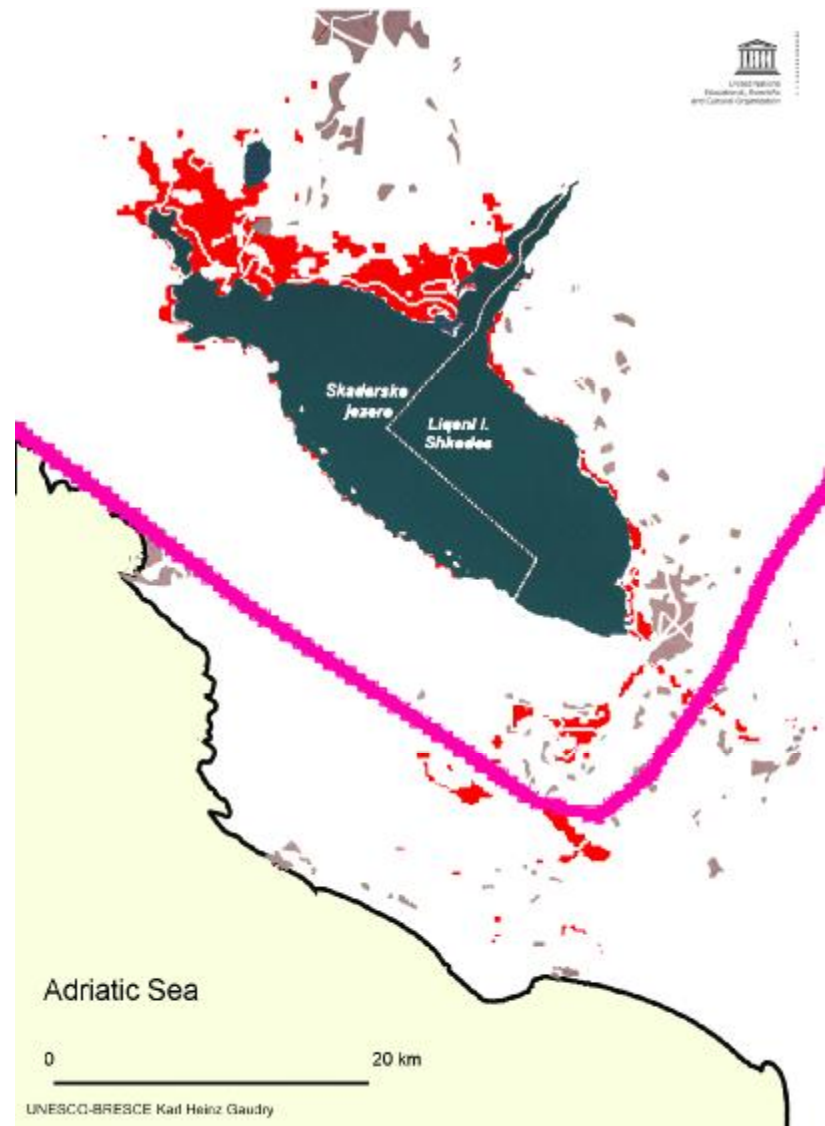

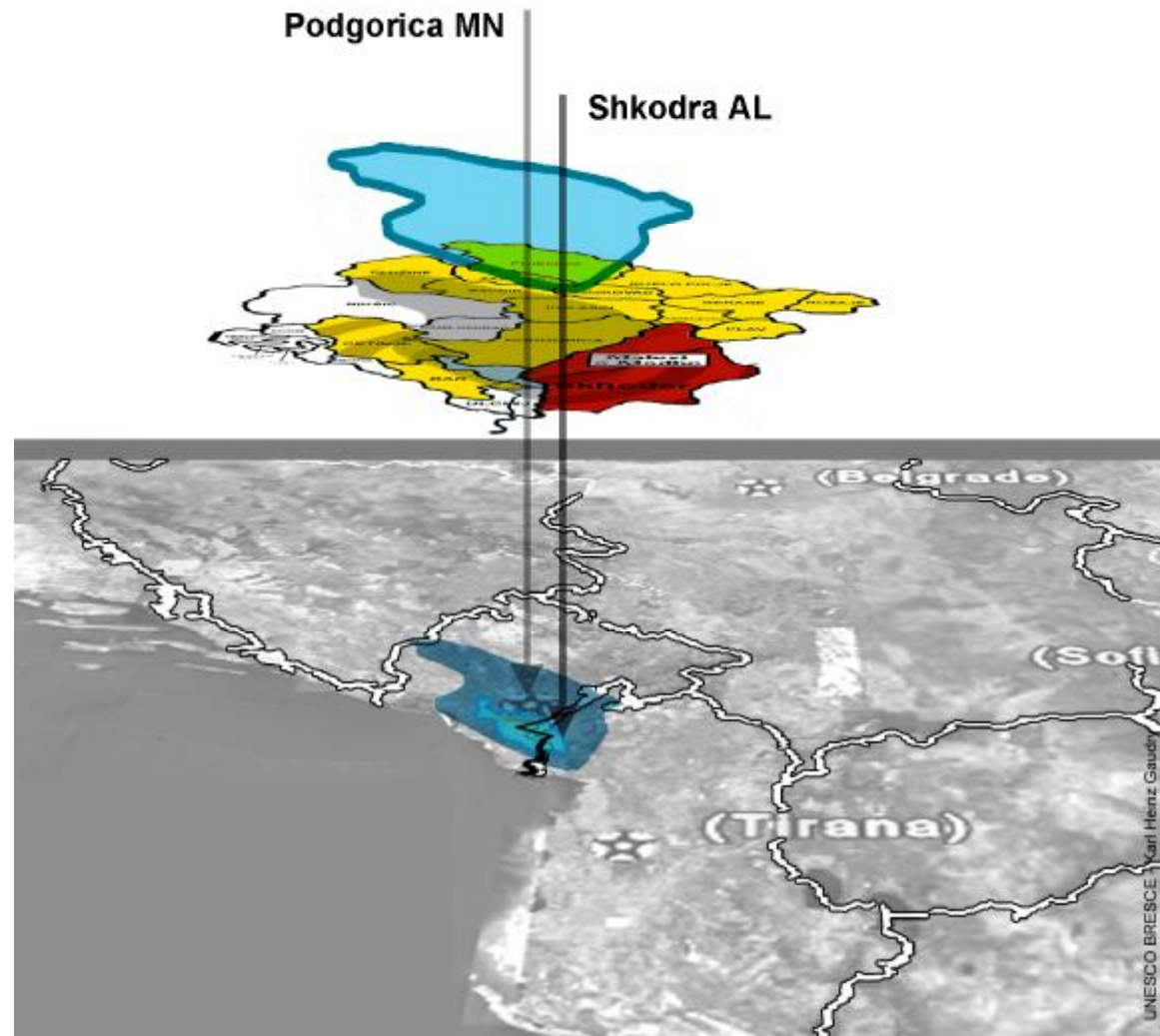
